
215

With the help of volunteers and generous donors, we build decent and affordable homes that provide a solid foundation for people to build better, healthier lives

in Canada and around the world. Habitat homeowners volunteer 500 hours and pay an affordable mortgage – geared to their income – to buy their home.

Our model of affordable homeownership bridges a gap for people who face barriers to homeownership. We provide working families on low incomes with the opportunity to purchase their own Habitat home.
