He'll be helping build homes with Habitat for Humanity Niagara as they celebrate their 25th Anniversary Build project by building five homes in Welland, Ontario, that will provide local families in need of

decent housing with an affordable homeownership opportunity.

Habitat Niagara builds decent, and affordable houses, providing no-down-payment, interest-free mortgages to qualifying families who would otherwise not be able to purchase their own homes. Habitat is not a giveaway program in that we provide "a hand up not a hand out." Established locally in 1993, Habitat Niagara will be constructing its 62nd home in Niagara by the end of this year, serving 68 families over the past 25 years, creating stable and secure housing for 239 children. Habitat for Humanity Niagara also operates a retail outlet – the ReStore – selling donated new and used building materials, hardware, appliances, and home supplies. Revenue from the ReStore supports our overhead costs ensuring that **every donated dollar** goes directly to building affordable homes for families.
