Reporting to the Board of Directors, the CEO will oversee all aspects of HFHMVI's operations, including strategic planning, real estate development, philanthropy, financial stewardship, and organizational growth. Key Responsibilities:

Strategic Leadership: Develop and implement a rolling three-year strategic plan and annual operating plans, guiding HFHMVI toward achieving its long-term and short-term goals. Work within the federated model for Habitat for Humanity Canada to achieve compliance with corporate requirements while maintaining the autonomy of the Nanaimo affiliate.

Philanthropy & Fundraising: Collaborating with the philanthropic community to increase donations and in implementing fundraising activities that provide sustainable sources of revenue.

Community and Partner Relations: The primary spokesperson of HFHMVI, promoting the organization's mission and forging relationships with donors, government officials, and community stakeholders.

Real Estate Development: Oversee land acquisition, real estate transactions, development projects, and negotiations with developers and local governments. Ensure successful project approvals and manage land and construction financing.

Financial Management: Ensure fiscal responsibility, develop annual budgets, and maintain strong financial controls in line with industry standards.

Communications: Develop and execute a communications strategy to maintain a strong HFHMMVI brand and enhance community awareness of its mission and impact.

Organization and Business Leadership: Lead and develop the senior leadership and broader team through strong collaboration and communication, ensuring robust performance across construction, social enterprises, finance, family services, volunteer management, fundraising and community outreach.
